Dear Parents/Carers

As you are aware, the Industrial Action planned for Wednesday 15th March 2023 and Thursday 16th March 2023 is scheduled to go ahead. On both days, the school will be closed to students in Year 7, Year 8, Year 9 and Year 10. The school will be open for Year 11 students who are expected to attend as they will be undertaking mock examinations.

The timings of the school day will be slightly different. Students will have an extended lunch period as well as finishing a little earlier than normal at approximately 2:30pm (this is dependent on how long it takes to get examinations started). Year 11 students will be expected on site at the normal time of 8:40am.

We will also be inviting some Year 10 students into school on one or both of the days to complete essential coursework. These students alongside a small number of other invited students will be contacted directly by college staff, the school day for these students will follow the normal timings. Students who are not in school will be supplied with a learning resource sheet so they can access study materials from home during the two days.
