Dear Parent/ Carer,

First of all, thank you so much for all of your support over the recent weeks, months and years. It has been a privilege to work with your child in Year 11 and see them develop into the amazing, unique young adult that they have become.

We also want to express our admiration and gratitude to your child, who has had the most turbulent 18 months of any school child in recent history. If students have not yet purchased a Prom ticket they can still do so by contacting the Year 11 Office or they are welcome to come into reception and a member of the Year 11 team will meet with them. If there are any outstanding payments, these can be settled by ParentPay or money can be brought into reception.

Last of all, thank you for everything. Your child has helped to make The Marvell College a wonderful place to be and they were an integral part of our journey to being rated "Good in all areas" by Ofsted. We wish you, and them, every success.
