

The Marvell College: Provider Access Policy

Introduction

This policy statement sets out the academy's arrangements for managing the access of providers to pupils at the school for the purposes of giving them information about the provider's education or training offer. This complies with the school's legal obligations under Section 42B of the Education Act 1997.

Student entitlement

Students in years 8-11 are entitled:

- To find out about technical education qualifications and apprenticeships opportunities, as part of a careers programme which provides information on the full range of education and training options available at each transition point.
- To hear from a range of local providers about the opportunities they offer, including technical education and apprenticeships – through school careers events and opening evenings/days.
- To understand how to make applications for the full range of academic and technical courses.

Premises and facilities

The school will make the appropriate provision for space and resources available for discussions between the provider and students, as appropriate to the activity. The school will also make available AV and other specialist equipment to support provider presentations. This will all be discussed and agreed in advance of the visit with Damian Matthews. Providers are welcome to leave a copy of their prospectus or other relevant course literature at Reception, this will be displayed in the student social area, which is available to students at lunch and break times.
