Dear Parent/Carer

Re: Partial Reopening for Year 10

I hope you and your family are safe and well. As I am sure you are aware, **schools remain closed for students until further notice, except for vulnerable students and the children of key workers.**

The government's plan for re-opening schools announced earlier this week is still **conditional**, and by no means certain. Schools will only begin a phased re-opening if the "5 key tests set by government" are being met. Should these conditions be met we are planning to re-open the school to Year 10 students from Monday 15th of June 2020. When students do return it will be in small groups (max 15 per class) and only 25% of the entire year group will be in school at any one time.

We are still working on what that face to face contact with Year 10 might look like, but we will keep you updated as our planning progresses over the next fortnight. **Year 10 students should continue to study online at home until we communicate to them exactly how the face to face supplement to their continued remote education will be delivered.**

Please complete the form by Wednesday 3rd June 2020.

I would like to thank you in anticipation of completing the electronic form, it will enable us to plan for how we manage the school over the next few weeks.

Please continue to take care and stay safe. Please rest assured that we are doing all we can to ensure that when school does eventually reopen it will be a safe place for all of us to work and study.
