Re: Plant Pot Design and Painting

The Art, Design and Technology department are writing to detail an after school workshop which will be available to all Year 8 students in the coming weeks. The workshop will be set up on a three week rota for up to 16 students at a time, to ensure social distancing measures can be adhered to.

Details of the workshop: Plant Pot Design and Painting

Week 1: Students will create a stencil design relating to the chosen brief of saving our seas, and begin to sketch their design onto two plant pots.

Week 2: Students will complete their hand drawn design and begin to use painting techniques to decorate their plant pots.

Week 3: Students will complete the painting of their plant pots and photograph their outcomes.

Following the workshop, one of the plant pots will be sold at an open event before the summer holidays, where parents and residents of the local community will be invited to view or purchase the student outcomes. All funds raised will be invested in art projects within the community. The other plant pot will be used or displayed within the schools community garden.
